By encouraging – or even requiring – Entered Apprentices and Fellow Crafts to participate in lodge outreach, you demonstrate the importance of relief, help deepen their connection with fraternal family, and set an early precedent for active involvement in the lodge.

Shadowing

Ask Entered Apprentices or Fellow Crafts to accompany experienced brothers on home visits to elder members; to assist elder members with filling out Masonic Assistance applications; and even to sit in on outreach phone calls. This will build their confidence and prepare them to take the lead.

Buddy system

Connect each Entered Apprentice and Fellow Craft with an elder brother. Encourage them to get together at the elder's home so he can share his Masonic experiences, and suggest that the younger member provide transportation to lodge. These relationships can lead to a learning opportunity for the younger Mason, a chance for regular home outreach visits, and a source of fellowship for both brothers.
