JOB SUMMARY

The Family Therapist is responsible for providing direct clinical services to families seeking help with a range of complex problems. The position's primary function will be to provide family and couples therapy grounded in systems and relational theory. The therapist is expected to conduct intakes, develop and lead parenting workshops, and provide case management as needed. The position works within a multi-disciplinary clinical care team model, and will participate in meetings and case conferences.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

The position is responsible for:

- Providing family, couple, and group therapy
- Conducting clinical intakes and assessments
- Assessing and treatment planning for active case load
- Referring into other modalities within the clinic as needed
- Documenting all client care in our EMR system
- Providing clinical care that complies with all the legal and ethical standards set by the field and the state of California
- Leading parenting/mindfulness workshops as appropriate

- Clinical team provide clinical consultation to colleagues to contribute to the quality of care provided by the center.
- Leadership team contribute to the creation of workshop curriculum.
- The Leadership team, contribute to the Continuing Education program
