JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Personal care assistance to residents, including bathing and other personal hygiene
- Preparation and assistance with mealtime tasks with residents
- Compliance with all HIPAA requirements for the privacy and dignity of residents
- Use of Resident Care Plans in ensuring continuity of care for residents
- Documents all activities and creates clear communication for other team members regarding resident care
- Performs transfers or lifts safely and within guidelines
- Performs routine vital signs tests for residents and documents appropriately, and reports changes to Nurses
- Performs routine cleanup as required
- Provide routine daily medications, either prescription or non-prescription, to residents whose condition and drug regimen are stable
- Ensures that proper dosage and supply of medicines is on hand per care plan for resident
- Respects the dignity and privacy of residents in all actions
