Pet Therapy Guidelines

- ✚ We welcome dogs and owners who can provide certification of K-9 good citizenship or evidence of training at Furry Friends, Delta, or Ohlone. Dogs must be previously socialized.
- ✚ Acceptance of volunteer applications is at the discretion of Volunteer and Community Resource Manager Carlene Voss.
- ✚ We will require a "meet and greet" walk-through tour when you begin to make sure that everyone is comfortable.



- ✚ Pets must be clean, well groomed, and free of fleas/ticks.
- ✚ All pets brought in by volunteers must have the following on file in the Volunteer and Community Resource office:
 - ✓ Name, address, and phone number of the owner.
 - ✓ For each pet, current health records showing all necessary vaccines are up to date.
 - ✓ Name, address, and phone number of the owner's veterinarian, in case of emergency.
